Dear ECB Provisional Licensee:

On May 9, 2024, Senate Bill 122 was passed by the Alabama Legislature. This law allows for the continuation of provisional electrical licenses for those who already possess a provisional license. No *new* provisional electrical contractor licenses may be issued by the Board. Any person who currently holds an active provisional electrical contractor license may continue to apply for the annual renewal of that provisional license. This law also requires submission of all local licenses or permits issued to the provisional licensee with the renewal application.

A completed renewal application and documentation establishing that the provisional licensee holds a valid local license or permit is required. A local license or permit issued by a county or municipality authorizes the holder to perform electrical contractor tasks and functions only within the boundaries of the issuing county or municipality. The provisional electrical contractor license does not expand the limited geographical boundaries imposed by the local license.

The enclosed renewal application with copies of all active local business licenses must be completed and submitted to the Board for approval. Once approved and processed, your renewed provisional license will be issued and mailed, and will be valid through June 30, 2025.

Any changes to personal information such as mailing address, email, phone, etc. can be noted on the renewal application.
